### **Digging Deeper**

1. Read v. 4. Discuss how periods of success and ease CAN be detrimental to our walk with the Lord. In fact, read v. 30 to see where it lead King Nebuchadnezzar's heart.
2. What particularly offends God about Nebuchadnezzar? Read v. 17 and 32 for a clue.
3. What does Nebuchadnezzar need to do? Look to a different response to sin from King David in Psalm 51:17.

### **Reflection**

1. There are many responses to our sin when it is exposed--by God's Word, by a sermon, by a friend. We can hide; minimize or gloss over; make excuses; blame others, etc. Which of these do you fall prey to?
2. Is there any sin you need to confess tonight? Is church...community group...a safe to confess sin and brokenness before the Lord? How could you help make it so?
3. Close the night thanking God for his kindness, his longsuffering and patience towards sinners.
